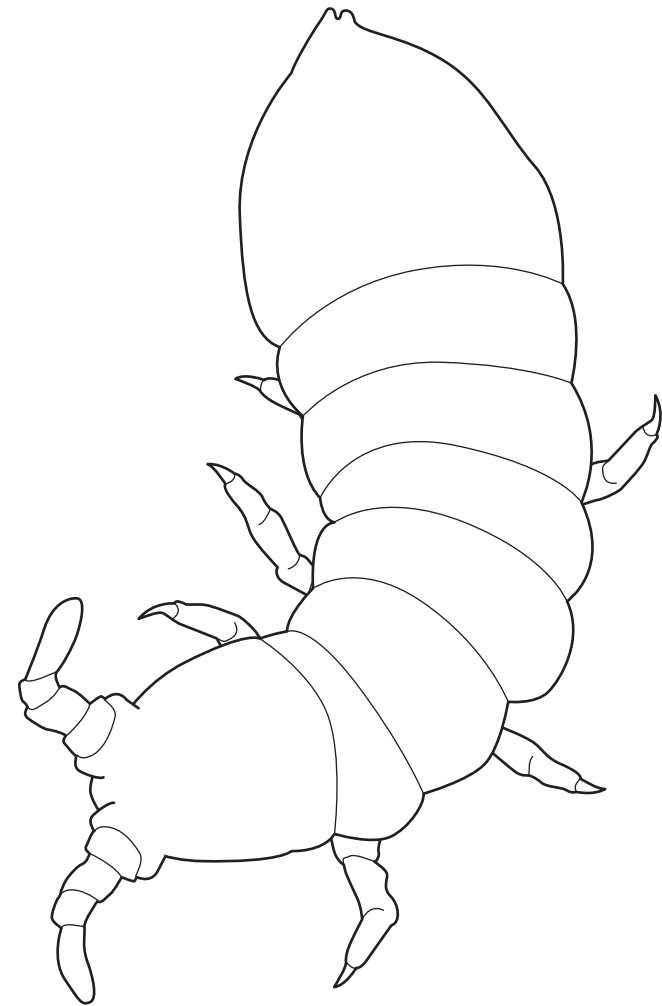
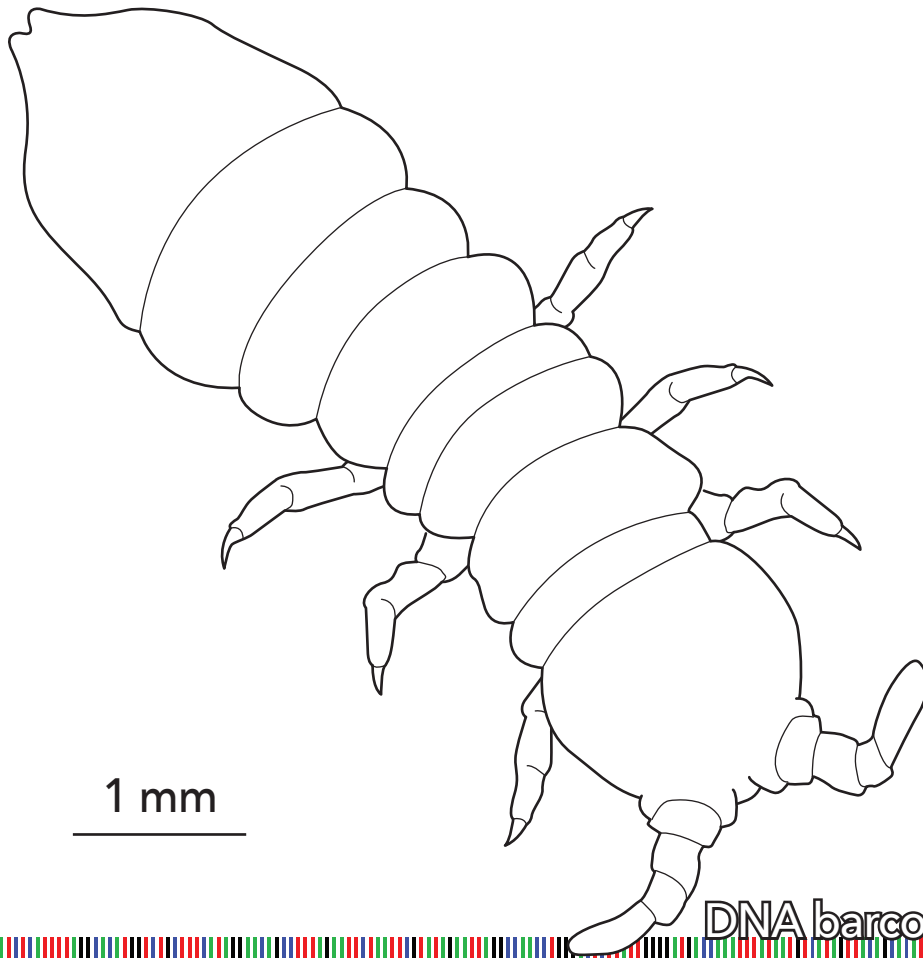


Arctic Springtail (*Megaphorura arctica*)

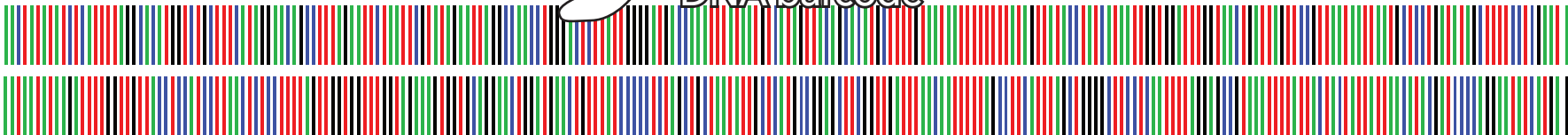
- Also known as snow fleas, they have a tail-like appendage that helps them leap into the air
- They can put their bodies into a dried-out cryogenic state and survive at -20 °C or lower
- Although they look like it, these tiny six-legged creatures are not actually insects
